Well done to all our year 11's who have now finished their GCSE and functional skills exams, we are certainly sad to see you go but very excited to see what the future brings for all of you.

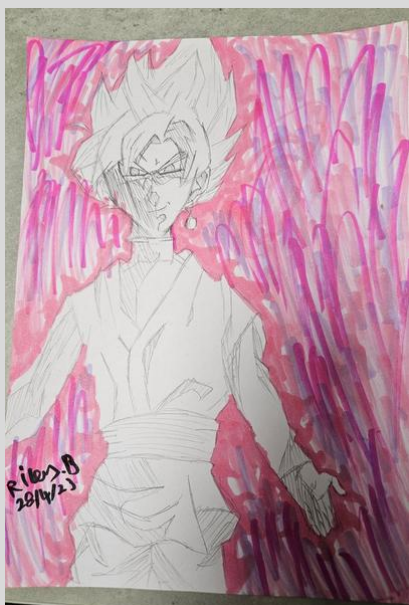

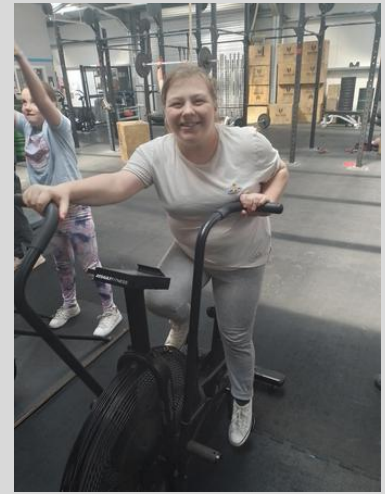

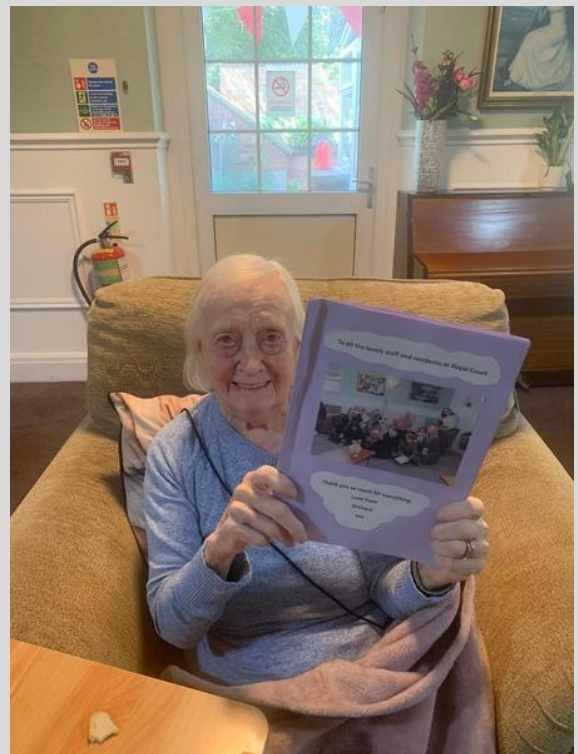
